peaked at the end of the Tokugawa period. Towards 1960, more than one million hats from Etchū-Fukuoka are sold annually.

600 Years of History: a Traditional Agricultural Tool

A winnowing basket (fujimi) is an agricultural tool used to separate grain from chaff. Made of sturdy wisteria vines that were stretched by being beaten against the bamboo, the basket is popularly recognized as a lucky charm (fukumi).



The old Hokuriku region main road is lined with many sugegasa warehouses. Even now, traces of its prosperity still remain. The lord of the Kaga family used to travel on this road for the purpose of Sankin-kōtai (a policy requiring feudal lords to alternate living between the capital and their domain yearly).
