1000 Years: Everlasting Japanese Washi Paper


The traditional Japanese paper made in Toyama Prefecture's Gokayama, Yatsuo, Hirudan regions is collectively referred to as Etchū-washi. Among the latter, the washi made of 100% kozō (paper mulberry) in Gokayama is particularly durable and was used as Kaga Domain exclusive writing paper. In addition to being used for repairing old documents, washi is used in collaboration with designers to create neat accessories, which are widely discussed at trade fairs overseas.






